Objectives

The First Level Degree Course in Sciences of Legal Services (SSG) allows students to gain full awareness about all the rules governing everybody's actions, through the definition of the rights, the duties, and the safeguard that regulations give them as individuals and members of a community. Knowing rules from a private and public point of view, their assessment on a historical level and the economic-statistical declination of the discipline composing the several branches of Law represent the fundamentals of the students' future training. They will improve their skills by acquiring the practical ability to identify and apply the functioning rules of enterprises and of their production phenomena, of public administrations in their multiple articulations, and of the relationships in the different national and international work fields.

These important areas of human activities are involved in three educational careers included in our degree course (Legal Business Operator, Legal Operator of Public Administrations and Labour Consultant), which, after a common two-year period, will develop highly specialised professional skills in the three areas described during the third year.

Career opportunities

The course in "Legal Business Operator" will give students the opportunity to deal in the supervision of legal and economic affairs of enterprises or non profit organisations, as a consultant, internal or external one, in the legal commercial and administrative office in charge for the management of business relationships, for the arrangement of contracts, for the advertising performances, the management of controversies and, more generally, the settling of problems characterising the vital cycle of the business activities.

The career in "Legal Operator of Public Administrations" will allow the access to competitions called for responsibility positions and high qualifications in authorities and public administrations (municipalities, regions, State) or in functional bodies (University, Chamber of Commerce, Local Health Authorities, Tax Revenue Agency, Inps, Inail, Labour Inspectorate, etc.) and in judicial administrations.

The "Labour Consultant" career represents the basis to acquire the professional licence allowing students to start an independent contractor activity. Alternatively, the acquired skills will allow students to perform a qualified activity as a consultant and an assistant in the staff management, supporting employers and professionals operating in the different economic sectors, from the traditional to the most innovative ones. Besides the work opportunities, the knowledge acquired in the three curricula could be useful for the progress and requalification of a previous working activity or for the successful continuation of an academic career.

International programmes

International exchange programs funded by the Erasmus+ and Globus grants allow students to study, take exams or do traineeships in a European or extra-European country. Comparing other systems will contribute to enrich the students' skills offering new stimuli for a personal growth and improving their abilities to face future challenges.

Admission requirements

A high-school diploma or an equivalent qualification is required to access the course of Legal Services Sciences.
